Deadline: Monday, February 28th

Rules:

- You are eligible to enter if you live in or go to school in Orleans Parish and are in grades K–12. All participants will receive a free book.
- Only one entry per participant.
- Visual artwork should be on an 8.5”x11” sheet of paper. If submitted digitally, send as either PDF or JPG files. Artwork may be submitted in person to a Library location, with this submission form paperclipped to the artwork.
- Videos and musical pieces must be no longer than 5 minutes and submitted as either MOV or MP4 files.
- Individuals or small groups of 2–3 students may work on videos or musical pieces.
- Videos and musical pieces must not contain explicit language or images.
- All work must be original. Videos and musical pieces must use original video/sound material or video/sound material that is licensed for use under Creative Commons.
- The deadline for entries is **Monday, February 28, 2022**, at midnight. Late entries will not be accepted.

Ways We Stay Healthy: Health and Wellness in the Black Community

Honor the past, witness the present, or envision the future. From the Black Panther Party’s People’s Free Medical Clinics to ways to stay healthy during the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic and beyond, share your interpretation of health and wellness in the Black community.

Send image or link to your video or musical artwork to **contest@nolalibrary.org**. In the “Message” field, write your name, grade, phone number or email, and the name of the school you attend.

How to Submit Video/Musical Art via WeTransfer:

Go to wetransfer.com and enter **contest@nolalibrary.org** in the “Email to” field. You may be asked to agree to their terms of service first. In the “Message” field, write your name, grade, phone number or email, and the name of the school you attend. Click the “transfer” button.
