### Teen Tech Center Rules

#### 1. Food

- No food is allowed in the library.

#### 2. Drinks

- No drinks are allowed in the sound booth.
- Drinks must have a top in the rest of the library.

#### 3. Illness

- If you feel sick, stay home. If you have fever, cough, or shortness of breath, call your primary care provider. If you do not have a primary care provider, call the Louisiana Department of Health hotline at 1-855-523-2652

### Expectations

#### 1. Respect everyone at all times

- **Avoid touching or writing on anything that does not belong to you.** Maintain a safe and comfortable space between yourself and others.
- **Pick up after yourself.** Don't expect others to clean up your mess.
- **No cursing.** Be kind with your words and actions.
- **Be gentle with the technology,** it belongs to everyone. Remember this is a shared space.

#### 2. Use this space to create

- The Best Buy Teen Tech Center wants to help you become a **content creator, not content consumer.**

#### 3. Listen while you learn

- When you are being taught how to do something new, **listen to instruction actively.** That means committing what you've learned to memory so you can **do it on your own next time.**

#### 4. Take responsibility for your actions

- **Own up to your mistakes** if you are confronted about breaking a rule. Part of being respectful to others is being honest with yourself.
