Teen Tech Center Rules

1. Food

- Eating is prohibited in the library.

2. Drinks

- No drinks **are not** allowed in the sound booth.
- Drinks must have a top.

3. One-on-One Instruction

- Instruction is available Tuesday - Friday. **No instruction is available on Saturdays.**

Expectations

1. Respect everyone at all times

- **No cursing.** Be kind with your words and actions.
- Be gentle with the technology, it belongs to everyone. Remember this is a shared space.

3. Take responsibility for your actions

- Take responsibility for your mistakes when questioned about breaking a rule.
- **If you can not follow the member expectations, you will be asked to leave for the day and risk losing your membership. This rule applies to both individuals and groups. If one person in a group breaks a rule, the entire group may be asked to leave and risk losing membership.**
