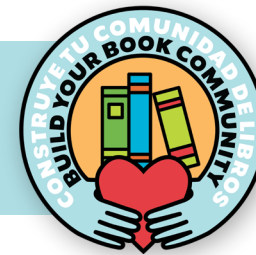

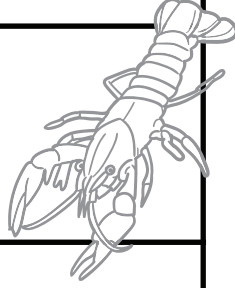
- Read How Ya Wanna: Picture book, graphic novel, audiobook, Wonderbook... you choose!

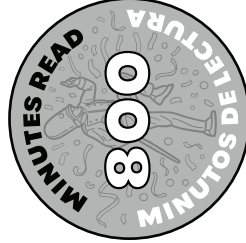

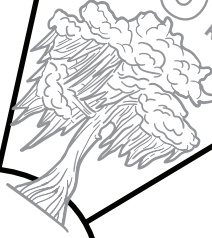
